DIRECTOR-GENERAL'S EXAMINATION CHARGE TO BAR PART I 2021 STUDENTS

The Director-General, Prof. Isa Hayatu Chiroma, SAN, on May 5, 2021 addressed the 2021 Bar Part I students, at the Main Auditorium of the Nigerian Law School Headquarters Bwari, Abuja.

The Director-General was accompanied by the Secretary to Council and Director of Administration, Mrs. Elizabeth O. Max-Uba, Director of Administration (Personnel Services) Mrs. Rita O. Areh, Director and Head of Academics, Mr. Samuel Osamolu, Director and Law Librarian, Mrs. Olayinka Tuyo, Director of Academics, Mr. Femi Afolayan, Director of Academics, Mr. Obi Okoye and Director of Academics, Mrs. B. Shuwa (Bar Part I Coordinator).



The Deputy Director and Head, Information and Protocol Mr. Chinedu Ukekwe gave a brief profile of the Director-General.



The Director-General's address basically was centered on the forthcoming Bar Part I Examination, reiterating the rules and regulations governing the conduct of the exams likewise the expectations of the students in terms of examination requirements. He said, the essence of writing exams is to test knowledge, skills and values acquired.

The Director-General advised them to avoid rushing to answer questions. They should read, understand and know the expectation of the examiners before answering the questions. He added that this year, there would be no Bar I Resit Exams, believing that as long as they were on the program for the last 3-4 months, attended all class activities, studied hard and prepared well, they will pass their exams.



He concluded that they should avoid exams malpractice and misconduct, because it is a strict liability offence which has severe consequences. He wished them success.

Thereafter questions were raised and the Director-General responded to all. Vote of thanks was given by the Class Representative.
